

### Faith and Healing: The Person Praying

- “Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, “Why could we not cast it out?” He said to them, “Because of your little faith. For truly, I say to you, if you have faith as a grain of mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, ‘Move from here to there,’ and it will move; and nothing will be impossible to you.” -*Matthew 17:19-20*

### **The Re-Presenting Jesus Model**

- *Explain:* Hebrews 12:2 tells us to “fix our eyes upon Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith.” The Holy Spirit loves to make Jesus so present and real to us. I am going to pray for Holy Spirit to make Jesus present to you right now. You might sense him in front of you, beside you, behind you or within you. Is that OK?
- *Prayer:*
  - i) [You praying]: Holy Spirit, “I ask you to show [name of person receiving prayer] where Jesus is right now.” [wait]
  - ii) [Prayee repeating after you]: “Jesus, where are you right now?”
    - *Where is Jesus? What are you seeing/sensing?*
  - iii) [Them repeating after you]: “Jesus, do you want to heal me right now?”
- Continue with prayer selection and prayer ministry.
