Q2. Hearing God & Prophetic Gifts

11 “So shall my word be that goes forth from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and prosper in the thing for which I sent it.” *-Isaiah 55:11*

17 “Thus faith comes from what is heard,
and what is heard comes through the
word (*rhema*) of Christ.” -*Romans 10:17*

The value that you place on the word you receive, whether in prayer or prophecy, determines the power you receive from it.

3 “He who prophesies speaks to men for their upbuilding and encouragement and consolation.” -1 Corinthians 14:3

Do not minister to the condition of the person's heart. Always minister the word of the Lord.

9 “For we know only in part, and we prophesy only in part.” -1 Corinthians 13:9

Dishonest or disingenuous feedback is not kindness.

Words of Knowledge (*what's happened/or what's happening*): supernatural revelation about something that is true of the **past** to **present** and important to God about the person.

Prophecy (*what's coming*): a word about the **present** into the **future** that displays the plans that God has for a person/group. Words true present to future.

Words of Wisdom *(how to get there):*

God's perspective on how to **apply** God's plans for our lives - God's **coaching** on how to pursue your destiny.

Discernment of Spirits *(who's involved):*

Supernatural revelation regarding the **motivating spirits** – good or evil – involved in a particular situation.

Example: “God is going to heal the anxiety in your heart in this season that was caused when you broke up with your girlfriend and went to the seminary through making consistent declarations of truth over your vocation. I see that your guardian angel is protecting you from demonic attacks so do not fear the enemy.”

Forthtelling

A word from God is declared and causes something to happen. It is calling something into being that is not as if it was.

9 “Then he said to me, “Prophecy to the breath, prophecy, mortal, and say to the breath: Thus says the Lord God: Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe upon these slain, that they may live.” 10 I prophesied as he commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they lived, and stood on their feet, a vast multitude.” -*Ezekiel 37:9*

Foretelling

Knowledge of future events.

8 “As you approach the town, you will meet a procession of prophets coming down from the high place with lyres, timbrels, pipes and harps being played before them, and they will be prophesying. 9 As Saul turned to leave Samuel, God changed Saul’s heart, and all these signs were fulfilled that day.”

-1 Samuel 10:8

Prophetic Process

1. Revelation
2. Interpretation
3. Application
4. Feedback
5. Sealing - *In the name of Jesus I bless every word that was from the heart of God that they would bear fruit and I break the power of any words not from God to have any influence over you.*
