Prophetic Team Leaders

Prophetic Team Process

1. **Welcome:** make the person receiving feel welcome and valued. Share names and make a connection!
2. **Introduction and Expectations**
 - a. **Goal:**
 - i. *“God has an amazing plan for your life and our only desire is to hear what He has to say to us about you to connect you closer to his heart and his plans for your life.*
 - b. **Discernment:**
 - i. *Our job is to listen to and declare to you what he’s saying to the best of our knowledge.*
 - ii. *Your job is to discern what is authentically from God and what is good for you.*
 - c. **Expectations:**
 - i. *We’re going to be silent and connect to God. After we have a chance to hear his voice, I’m going to prophesy first, and then we’ll go around the circle. During this time, you don’t have to do anything.*
 - d. **Humility:**
 - i. *Our team is still growing in our ability to hear God’s voice and we want to know what actually connects with you from what we share after we prophesy over you. This will help us grow in our ministry.*
 - e. **Prayer Goals:**
 - i. *If there is a specific area of your life you would like us to pray into, please let us know. If not, we will just freely listen to whatever we hear the Holy Spirit saying to us for you.*
 - f. **Agreement:**
 - i. *Does this sound good? Do you have any questions?*
3. **Ministry**
 - a. A short period of silence to go through the prophetic process
 - b. The leader gives the first word and then goes around the circle. (Please keep your prophetic word under 90 seconds.)
 - c. The leader should help keep things on track.
 - d. If possible, share feedback as a team between guests so any issues can be resolved
4. **Feedback**
 - a. The leader initiates feedback from the receiver. Encourage the guest to be honest and not worry about hurting our feelings or trying to make us feel good.
5. **Sealing Prayer:** *In the name of Jesus, I bless every word that was from God to bear fruit in your life. If there are any words spoken that were not from God, I brush them aside in the name of Jesus that they would have no influence on your life.*

Two Modes of ministering in teams

Simply prophesying one by one.

Ministering one unified word through a team.

Prophet Team Activation

Explanation: We want to activate team prophecy. Each group will have a group leader who will facilitate the experience for guests. Alternatively, you can rotate your group leader for each guest.

Instructions: Today, for our activation, we will randomize you into groups. Each new group will use the handout and go through the process. Pick a Group Leader each round to go first.

1. Once you are sent into a group, one person will be the receiver and everyone else will take turns sharing their prophetic word (no more than 60 seconds). You can decide to use one of the following modes we discussed in class
 - a. Mode One: release words one by one, as you receive them
 - b. Mode Two: release words that continue and build upon the first word. You will work on 'flow' and pray/prophesy one word or theme through the whole group. This is more challenging at first.
2. After each person receives, share feedback that highlights the strongest/most accurate word (under 30 seconds)

Homework: From what you've learned in the words of knowledge sessions, take a further step this week and step out in faith to minister to someone through words of knowledge. Be prudent in your delivery as you've been taught and expect that God wants to minister through you. Write a journal entry of what you learn.
