

## I. Interview & Expectations

### 1. Check

- a. **Condition:** "Please describe your condition. When did it start?" (Mk 9:21)
- b. **Pain or Limitations:** "On a scale of 1-10, what is your pain level at now? Is there anything you can't do because of this condition (decreased mobility, shortness of breath, etc?)"

### 2. Consider

#### a. History

- i. "Was there anything traumatic going on in your life when this started?"
- ii. If there was something significant, invite them to say or repeat a prayer for forgiveness/repentance/mercy etc. Keep it simple. Be encouraging.

#### b. Faith

- i. **Ask:** "Do you believe Jesus wants to bring you healing now?"
- ii. **Have Them Ask:** "Jesus, do you want to heal me now?"
- iii. **Share Testimony:** Build faith by sharing healing from similar conditions.

### 3. Explain

#### a. Review the prayer process

- i. **Our Work:** "We are going to be silent and ask Jesus how he wants us to pray and then pray for you."
- ii. **Your Work:** "When we pray for you don't pray for yourself - just be aware of what God is doing."
- iii. **God's Work:** "After we pray we are going to check back in and see what God's doing."
  1. "You may feel heat, tingling, cool, and peace. This can be normal but not necessary for healing."

### 4. Invite

#### a. Confirm Understanding and Seek Agreement

- i. "Before we begin, do you have any questions?"
- ii. "Does this sound good to you?" or "Are you ready to start?"

## II. Prayer Selection - Holy Spirit, how do you want to heal this person?

1. **Prayer of petition:** A request to God to heal, Asking as a Son with authority! Power based on intimacy with the Father. "Fervent prayer of a righteous man is powerful" (James 5)
  - a. **"Father in the name of Jesus, I ask you to let your presence come and bring healing to -----."**
2. **Prayer of Command:** An authoritative act of faith addressed to a body part, a sickness or evil spirit. (Mt 10:1)
  - a. Body part: **"In the name of Jesus, I command the bones, ligaments, muscles and tendons, be healed"**
  - b. Sickness: **"In the name of Jesus I command this tumor to dissolve and disappear"**
  - c. Spirit: **"In the name of Jesus I command the spirit of affliction to leave now in Jesus name."**
3. **Prophetic Act:** An action done in the physical realm of what you're seeing in the spiritual realm that releases God's power to heal: **Father what are you doing? Or "How do you want to release healing right now?"** (Jn 9:6)

### III. Prayer Ministry

1. Ask Holy Spirit to come. Pause. Keep your eyes open.
2. Keep prayers short. Use a normal tone of voice. Pray in the name of Jesus. DO NOT MASSAGE!

### IV. Re-interview

1. **Test it out:** Faith is activated when trying to do something they couldn't do or re-checking pain level. (Mk 8:23)
  - a. **If improvement but not fully healed, repeat steps 2-4** at least three times or until 100% healed.
  - b. **If no improvement**, consider having them ask Jesus directly if there is someone to forgive or something to repent of. Afterwards, pray for healing again.
    - i. **Forgiveness:** In the name of Jesus, I forgive \_\_\_\_\_ for \_\_\_\_\_ .
    - ii. **Repentance:** In the name of Jesus, I repent for my sin(s) of \_\_\_\_\_. Jesus please forgive me and cleanse me in your blood. (If mortal sin, encourage them to go to confession later)
  - c. **If pain increases:** If pain is moving or increasing, it's likely a spirit of affliction or trauma. Shift to a command prayer: "In the name of Jesus I command the spirit of affliction to leave now in Jesus name."

### V. Post Prayer Suggestions

1. **If healed:** vocally claim in faith what Jesus has just done and have them command any post-healing symptoms to leave in Jesus' name. Encourage them to not partner with doubt.
2. **If no healing manifests**, you can
  - a. Share: Healing can be like a seed that manifests later. We've seen it! Offer A Testimony
  - b. Encourage: Persevere in prayer and understand that their suffering is not meaningless united to Jesus
  - c. Recommend: books, documentaries, other services, intimacy in prayer, scripture, sacraments, etc.
3. **Resist personal disappointment: If a person was loved, your prayer was successful!**
