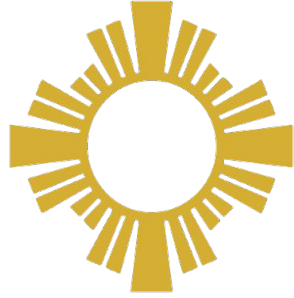

Q3. Power and Healing

Authority (exousia) - healing flows through the authority we have in Christ by faith over demonic oppression, sickness and infirmity.

“Then he summoned his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits to drive them out and to cure every disease and every illness... As you go, make this proclamation: ‘The kingdom of heaven is at hand.’ Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons. Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give.” (Matt 10:1, 7-8)

“These signs will accompany those who believe...they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover...they went forth and preached everywhere, while the Lord worked with them and confirmed the word through accompanying signs.” (Mark 16:18,20)

Anointing (charism) - healing flows through a spiritual gift of healing upon a person's life that releases the healing power of God.

“To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit...to another gifts (charisms) of healing by the one Spirit” (1 Cor 12:7,9)

“Now you are Christ’s body, and individually parts of it. Some people God has designated in the church to be, first, apostles; second, prophets; third, teachers; then, mighty deeds; then, gifts of healing, assistance, administration, and varieties of tongues...Strive eagerly for the greatest spiritual gifts.” (1 Cor 12:27-28, 31)

Impartation - The transference of a spiritual gift or grace operating in the life and ministry of one person to be active in the life of another.

“For I long to see you, that I may **impart** to you some spiritual gift so that you may be strengthened.” Romans 1:11

“You ask me to go and see this person that I may heal her by a miracle; why do you not do it yourself? Go, I give you my power, not only for this infirm person, but also for all whom you may meet on the way.” - St Vincent Ferrer
